





The vineyard speaks: over time, since 1930, my vines in the meander of the Ebro have given excellent clusters of Tempranillo. Today I can introduce myself as Viña Gena, named in honor of Doña Genara Villota. The first Villota wine from Viñedo Singular.

6,502 bottles of 0.75 l and 250 magnums (1.5 l) were bottled.

**2019 VINTAGE.** The dry winter and a stormy late spring gave way to a model summer of moderate heat and little rainfall. In the final stretch of the maturation cycle, the conditions were extraordinary. Harvest was on 9/19/2019.

DOCA RIOJA RATING. "Excellent" (a rating that has not occurred since 2011).

VARIETIES. 100% Tempranillo from the oldest plot of the estate, Cepas Madre, planted in 1930. Due to its low yield and high quality, its grapes are destined to the official classification of Viñedo Singular.

**ELABORACIÓN.** After fermentation, the wine was aged for 18 months in French oak barrels before being refined in concrete vats. Bottled in May 2022.

NOTA DE CATA. Bright appearance, with a deep robe. Floral (fresh rose) and ripe fruit aromas (morello cherry, cherry, red plum), with subtle pastry notes -a touch of caramelised cream.

Fruity, fleshy and supple mouthfeel. Tannic structu-re and invigorating acidity. Fresh, with menthol nuances. Clean, deep, balanced.
